### **1. MISSIONS**

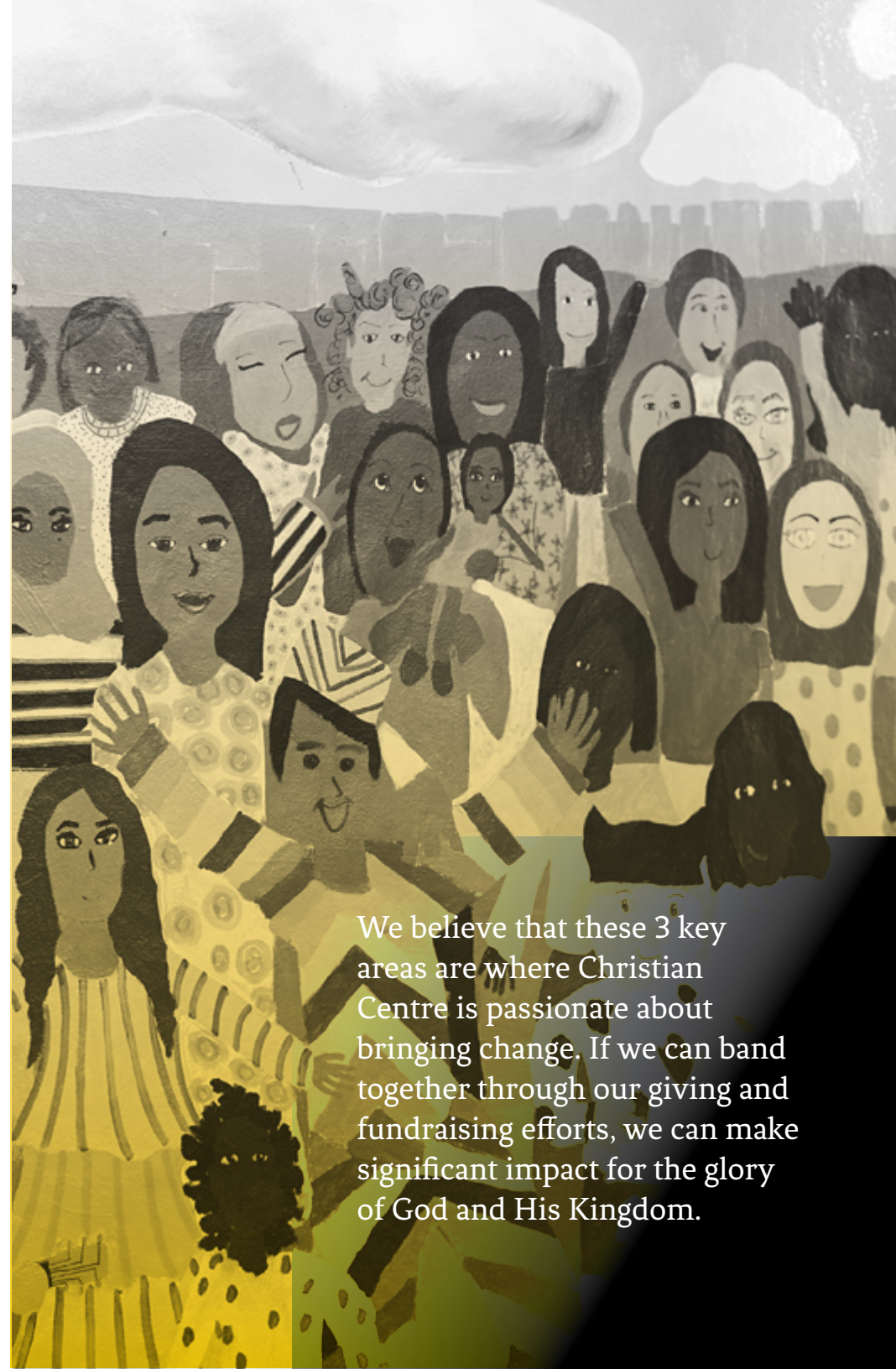
We care that people around the world hear and experience the reality of the Gospel through missions work.

# 1.0 MISSIONS

## 1.1 HAITI

Since 2010, Christian Centre has been partnering with Grace International in Haiti. A team was first sent to help with immediate relief after a massive earthquake devastated the country. Each year since, CCC has added to those efforts through reconstruction and housing initiatives, educational sponsorship, medical assistance, microfinancing and visitation to provide much needed emotional/spiritual encouragement.

## 1.2 BUILDING ME UP (JAMAICA)

Building Me Up, a ministry started by our own Alecia Griffiths, aims to provide children in rural and economically disadvantaged communities with the opportunity to mature spiritually, achieve their potential, excel and become leaders. Programs, summer camps (including a lunch program) and events are offered annually (free of cost) in various communities. Recently, Building Me Up built a school library with 2000 donated books and sent crates of food, clothing and educational resources to local churches and schools. The current goal is to purchase 50 tablets to distribute to schools and children disadvantaged by Covid-19.

### 1.3 AT-RISK OUTREACH (INDIA)

Millions of children in India suffer from discrimination, oppression, and terrible poverty, all for being born to low-caste families. Paul W has visited Christian Centre a number of times to report on his work among India's most vulnerable children. He currently assists with the Evangelical Fellowship's Children @ Risk outreach, in rescue and rehabilitation of trafficked low-caste and outcast children and young people. He also helps strengthen the church in restricted and difficult areas through providing resources and training in our PAOC affiliated Bible Schools.

### 1.4 UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP (MIDDLE EAST)

We are thrilled to be part of an exciting new opportunity to expand the kingdom of God into new territory. This project will allow global workers to begin a ministry among an unreached people group in the Middle East. This people group is 99% Muslim and highly marginalized within their society. Our giving, which will be matched by a private donor, will fund an outreach initiative (ie. a community development project, Covid relief, or small business) that will begin a relationship and open the door for future impact.

## 2.1 YOUTH EMPLOYMENT (ICO)

Inner City Outreach provides 10-20 work opportunities every year for young people in our community. For many, this is their first paying job, providing invaluable work experience and a source of income. A job with ICO allows young people to stay connected to our programs while giving back to their community.

## 2.2 STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

We are committed to supporting our students in their pursuit of higher education and training. Each of our scholarship recipients have earned their award through service to their community and/or church. By empowering them, we are investing in a generation of leaders.

## 2.3 COUNSELLING

The adolescent years are confusing enough, without navigating the added stresses created indirectly from Covid-19. Our society is facing a mental health crisis, which is particularly evident among our young people. This project aims to provide subsidized counselling for teens and young adults who face barriers to mental health services so they can access the support and care they need to heal and thrive.
